From the Desk of President Cheryl

To all members and guests of Ascension,

This past week we received a memo from the Synod announcing that they strongly recommend that churches statewide temporarily return to remote operations as COVID-19 infections and hospitalizations soar due to the highly- transmissible Omicron virus in Wisconsin. They recommend that churches not gather in person for the next 4-6 weeks,

After a conversation with Pastor Mains, and several Ascension church leaders, we have made the decision to remain open. Our current Covid protocols of mask wearing in every area of the church, social distancing in the Sanctuary and pews, and limiting our gathering and close conversations will be monitored to ensure the protocols are followed. Everyone who is attending any service must sign in before entering the Sanctuary.

We will expect everyone to be very cautious and follow the guidelines. If you are sick, feel sick, please stay home. We will continue to livestream our services so you can worship with us from home.

We have many things happening at Ascension in the months ahead. Pastor Mains will be here to help us and guide us as we move forward, our Capital Campaign will begin very soon, and our roof repairs will resume in early Spring.


Welcome 2022


