From the Desk of Pastor Bill

Dear Friends in Christ,

Last week I had someone relay a message to me from a group of ALC members who had gathered for lunch. The subject of worship services came up during their conversation. They specifically thought it was time that a Worship and Music Team be started up again. I think they're right. It would be quite helpful to have a Worship and Music Team, but I wonder how it should be established and how our cultural groups could be equally represented. I think it's vitally important that all our cultural groups be represented.

That got me to thinking. After going back to in-person worship, there have been several teams already in action. We have a Building Team that's overseeing the upkeep, repair, and use of our building. We have an HR Team that oversees the staff, hiring and releasing, and issues our employees experience. We have a Communications Team that is working hard on upgrading our website and putting together a new streaming set-up. We're in the process of putting together a Visitation Team. There is a team of volunteers who help with the Food Pantry.

And that got me thinking again. Are there any other teams we should get up and running? A couple come to mind. How about an Outreach Team? Or an Education Team for children? Or an Education Team for adults? Or a Hospitality Team to connect with new members or visitors? Are there other teams ALC has had in the past that got hit hard by the pandemic some time ago? Is it time to seek volunteers and energize a team from the past or even a new team for the future?

Please do some thinking about this during May. Drop a "Suggestions Note" into the offering plate after worship with your Team ideas. We'll share them with the congregation, discuss them with the Leadership Council. If something interests you personally, add your name to your "Suggestion Note." Not all new ideas have to come from the Pastor. I'm willing to bet we have a bunch of new ideas that just might be part of a New Beginning for the ministries of Ascension Lutheran Church.

Building Team Update

Good News! Spring weather has allowed work on the roof to begin again. Travelers on Layton Blvd. heading south can see the work in progress as shingles are removed from the roof above the sanctuary. The team is monitoring this ongoing project.

We also are continuing to focus on improving interior and exterior building safety. An onsite workshop led by a Milwaukee police officer was held in late March for tenants and staff to educate us in safe practices in the event of an active shooter.

Dead tree removal is scheduled for this summer and a contract for the installation of surveillance cameras on the exterior of the building is also in progress. An electrical contractor is awaiting materials that are needed to improve parking lot illumination with the goal of completing this project this summer.

Human Resources Update

Many thanks to Sue Kaschak for agreeing to be the interim chair of our Food Ministry. This ministry has been vital to families in our community during the pandemic and continues to support families during this time of economic challenges, so we are grateful that Sue and her crew of volunteers are sustaining this important work. Our Food Ministry is now serving 75 families, an increase of 25 needy families! The distribution occurs on the 1st and 3rd Thursday of the month. Food is collected and stored in the gymnasium while we await completion of the roofing above the pantry room that suffered water damage. Once the new roofing is in place, the pantry will be restored so that food items can once again be stored in that room.

NOTE: June distribution dates will be the 2^{nd} and 4^{th} Thursdays.


