More Than A Roof



The More Than a Roof three-year capital campaign that began in January 2022 with promises of \$508,866 came to a close on December 31st. Contributions at the close of the campaign amounted to \$585,882. The final months of the campaign resulted in some very generous gifts that exceeded our campaign goal by \$77,016. We are so grateful for the faithful and generous gifts that have been made.

The total cost of the new roof and air conditioning units was \$863,600. A 20 year loan with the Mission Investment Fund provided the funds to undertake this critical project. Money raised in our three year campaign allowed us to make the monthly principal and interest payments on this loan as well as some additional payments on the principal. The balance of the loan as of December 31st was \$418,167. We are grateful to learn that there are contributors who are extending their gifting to this fund to help reduce this debt. We are hopeful that others will join these faithful contributors.

Building Team

The Ascension Building Team is responsible for maintaining, restoring, updating, and repairing building property; reviewing tenant leases and contracts; recruiting volunteers for minor repairs; ensuring a safe, well-kept environment; prioritizing improvements; and overseeing special projects.

Over the past year, the Building Team worked on several projects:

- Completed Phase 1 of a fire alarm system upgrade, with Phases 2 and 3 planned for 2025 and 2026.
- Installed an updated computer system for Ascension office staff.
- Restored the amphitheater following flood damage.
- Secured a new insurance carrier for Ascension.
- · Searched for new tenants for spaces previously occupied by Street Angels and Children's Hospital.
- Handled lease renewals: The Synod lease is complete, The Gathering's is in progress, and renewals for SOC, LaFamilia, and Inner Beauty are planned for 2025.
- Developed property use policies and kitchen operating procedures.
- Monitored and addressed unauthorized overnight parking.
- · Continued repairs for circuits and water leaks.

The team has identified parking lot improvements as a major project for the coming year.

Ascension has a large and aging physical plant that require constant monitoring and system failures that require attention. Our building space also gives us the opportunity to partner with non-profit organizations that support our mission to be of service in the community and it also gives us income support for our church budget.

Stewardship

We conducted a fall Stewardship Drive in 2024 called "Because of God's Great Mercy". Through the use of mailings, emails, bulletin inserts and temple talks we encouraged our disciples to give generously to support God's work at Ascension. During this time of transition at church we characterize our results as both encouraging and challenging.

The number of giving unit pledges received to date for 2025 is 37, compared to 46 for 2024. The total number of pledged support for 2025 is \$128,405.84, compared to \$117,156.00 for 2024. Fourteen disciples increased their pledges from 2024 to 2025. In 2025 Grace and Ka Bao are planning to meet with Pastor Aida to engage more disciples in our Stewardship work and planning.

We ask you to remember that God's mercy comes to us in countless ways. Our Lord Jesus is chief among these. It is through the love and forgiveness that is ours in our Lord Jesus that we can boldly claim to be God's own people – not because of what we have done, but because of what God has done for us through his only Son.

Worship Planning

Laura sends the minutes to all disciples on the team & to the Office Manager.



This past year the team has consisted of Pastor Aida, Laura Ruiz, Jan Fox, Ar Lee, and Sterling Biggers. Occasionally, Office Manager Chuck Ellingson has been able to join us. Also, KaBao Yang participated when Ar Lee was unavailable. The team also consults with Roxanne Carloni to see if the Hand Bell Choir will be playing a piece for a Unified Worship Service and with Gao McCrary if she and her family will be singing. Our work consists of going through the liturgy, choosing hymns and organizing it all for a meaningful worship service. We are intentional to include music from all three language communities whenever possible which is why we have a representative from each language community as part of the group.

Our group begins each meeting with a prayer & concludes each meeting with a date to plan for the next Unified Worship service.

We appreciate all who participate not only in the planning but all those who attend the Unified Worship services. We plan on continuing to meet monthly via Google Meet. The virtual format has been very helpful for this team.

Handbell Choir:

The Handbell Choir rehearses from late September to early/mid-May, performing about every 5-6 weeks, including Christmas, Easter, and special events like Pastor Aida's installation. Rehearsals are held after the 9:00 service, with efforts to perform during unified services so all can hear the bells. Collaborations with Sterling Biggers and the House Band enhance some hymns. The group consists of seven full-time ringers, and outreach efforts to recruit from Hmong and Latino services continue. Music selections are being tailored to suit the smaller choir size.

A Note from Pastor Aida on Worship and Gathering

Right now, ALC is equipped with good technology to provide livestream worship services every Sunday. Currently we are livestreaming the unified & special services, and some Hmong worship services, as well. It would be ideal to include our English and Spanish worship services as well. For that, we would need to recruit at least one volunteer per worship service to be trained by Johnny Vang and Kou Thao, who are the ones doing it so far. It's important we livestream our services, since some of our temporarily "homebound" disciples have been requesting it. Also, I know by previous experience that livestream services can be an effective evangelism effort.

Ascension is already a hybrid church, since most of our meetings are done online. Providing steady online worship experiences every Sunday would be a very logical next step, especially if we already have the technology.

<u>Ascension in Mission (AMIS)</u>

AMIS has a 60 plus year history of mission support. In its early years the focus of AMIS (Ascension Mission) provided funds for missionary support in the greater church. It has since transitioned to provide financial support for local, national and global needs. The AMIS group meets quarterly in member homes for fellowship and discussion to identify programs that need financial support. The AMIS fund relies on the contributions of members, Thrivent Choice grants, \$5,000 of annual support from the Ascension Endowment Fund, and an annual fund raising event. The fund raiser for the past few years has been a fall sale of crysanthemum plants. The AMIS group has also sponsored fellowship following worship on a once a month basis. Free will offerings at this fellowship hour support materials needed for food as well as the general AMIS fund.

Ascension Endowment Board

"Forward with Christ, Adelante con Cristo, Nrug Yexus Moog"

It is quite remarkable that the message of Jesus to love the Lord and our neighbors as ourselves has been alive in our church in Milwaukee for almost 175 years. In 1852 a little group of Norwegian immigrants launched this mission and we now find ourselves, one Lutheran congregation with ministries in Hmong, Spanish and English having just called Pastor Aida Muniz to help lead us on the next steps of our amazing journey. In this Lenten season it is good to remember that 80 years ago on April 9, 1945, Hitler executed a Lutheran pastor, Dietrich Bonhoeffer, for staying true to Jesus. In 1944, while in prison, Pastor Bonhoeffer sent a letter to a friend with an Outline for a Book he had hoped to write when free. One of his conclusions is worthy of our close attention: "The church is the church only when it exists for others." We have much to do together.

Over 50 years ago, Ascension's leadership created the Ascension Lutheran Church Endowment Board as a separate legal entity but made up of Ascension disciples and committed to the work and mission of Ascension Lutheran Church. Over the years, Ascension's members have given hundreds of thousands of dollars to support our work ("[God's] people faithfully brought in the contributions, tithes and dedicated gifts." 2 Chronicles 31:12). Currently, the fund balance is roughly \$2.8 million.

Ascension disciples Jerry Vang, Kirsten Pezewski (treasurer), Chuck Kudy (secretary), Joan Semrad Hutchinson, Jim Andree, Laura Ruiz, Charlie Kudy, Cheryl Groth, and Mark Thomsen (president) serve on the Board. The Board, with help from Robert W. Baird advisor Shawn Zoltak, is responsible for the prudent investment and hopeful growth of the Fund. The Board is committed to continuing its \$100,000 a year contribution to support the budget and work of our Ascension Lutheran Church.

If you or a person you know wishes to contribute to this worthy cause, the Ascension Lutheran Church Endowment Board will warmly welcome the gift and put it to work for Jesus ("If anyone has material possessions and sees a brother or sister in need but has no pity on them, how can the love of God be in that person?" 1 John 3:17).
